

## **AVOID A TICKET**

Read these rules before parking your vehicle/trailer.

This marina is owned by the DNR. It's public land, NOT owned by Rowleys Bay Resort.

There are 15 slots for parking trucks and trailers south east of the resort. Follow the signs, or visit the front desk or [RowleysBayResort.com/marina](http://RowleysBayResort.com/marina) for a map. Please do your best to park properly so all the slots can be filled.

When this parking is full AS A COURTESY, non-guests may park in the Rowleys Bay Resort in designated parking spaces:

1. Designated parking spaces means IN MARKED PAINTED LINES. If your vehicle is not surrounded by lines, you're parked in the driveway or in a no-parking zone.
2. Please see the Rowleys Bay Resort front desk for maps and instructions if you need additional assistance.
3. If your vehicle is parked outside these areas and you are not a registered guest, you may be ticketed.

### **Please see the front desk for help!**

We DO appreciate our boating visitors! However, we simply cannot override the safety of the public and the convenience of our paying guests by allowing non-guests to park in unsafe areas.

### **REGISTERED GUESTS:**

Registered guests must consult with the front desk before parking and charging. Fire lanes, handicap entrances, non-parking spaces surrounding the building or grassy areas, electric car charging station, etc are not approved parking spaces for trailers and are hazardous to guests, utilities, and pedestrians.
